



What are Family Programming Grants?

Family Programming grants are intended to assist groups to run family and parenting programs for families with children aged 0-6. They include money for equipment, supplies, and some honoraria. Groups intending to run programs in St. Vital for parents with their children (age 0-6), or parenting programs for parents with children ages 0-6, are eligible.

What is the amount I can apply for under the Family Programming Grant?

Maximum \$5000 for a year.

What sorts of grants in this priority group could be considered?

- [Wiggle, Giggle & Munch](#)* groups
- Family Literacy (promoting literacy and learning for parents with their children) programs including both parents and preschool children
- [Book Bags](#)* workshops for parents with preschool children
- Parenting support groups
- Parenting groups (such as Positive Discipline, Nobody's Perfect, Handle with Care, Triple P, etc.)
- Nutrition education for families with pre-school children
- Fathers' parenting groups
- Facilitator training for above mentioned programs or other eligible programs

What is eligible?

Funds are to be used only for purchases of materials, supplies, and / or equipment, which are project specific. This could include:

- Developmentally appropriate books, toys and games
- Craft and snack supplies
- Relevant parenting DVDs and/or books
- Some of the facilitator fees or honoraria for facilitators and child minders

What is ineligible?

Funds are not to be used for salaries, rent, utilities, administrative fees or office equipment
